Examples of projects during the First Annual National Arab American Service Day

- September 24, 2005 -

In 2005, over 500 volunteers gathered around the country for a day of service. Here are some of the highlights:

Cleveland, OH

In partnership with the Ohio Youth Advocate Program which houses 3-18 year old orphans, the Arab American Community Center for Economic and Social Services spent an afternoon outdoors with the children in a local park, playing basketball, gardening, having lunch and doing crafts together.

Chicago, IL

Volunteers cleaned up the grounds of the Children's Place Association, which houses up to 60 children at a time who have AIDS and other serious illnesses.

Orlando, FL

Raised over \$11,000 and an entire truckload of clothes that were sent to help with the hurricane Katrina aftermath.

Dearborn, MI

Volunteers partnered with Mexicantown Community Development Corporation to carry out multiple projects in a Latino neighborhood, and paint lockers in a 100 year old inner city high school.

Brooklyn, NY

Volunteers organized multiple projects including stocking a food pantry, organizing a blood drive, and beautifying a local park.

Palos Hills, IL

Worked with an organization called Share Your Soles, which takes old shoes and refurbishes them to nearly new quality. Because of the timeliness, many of the shoes worked on were sent to victims of hurricane Katrina on the Gulf Coast.
